

## Deliverance Aftercare



- 1) God is your friend. Practice talking to Him and listening to Him: *I no longer call you servants...But I have called you friends, for everything that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you (John 15:15). My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me (John 10:27).*
- 2) Surround yourself with Holy Spirit filled believers with like mindedness: *Let us firmly hold the profession of our faith without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. And let us consider how to spur one another to love and to good works. Let us not forsake the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but let us exhort one another, especially as you see the Day approaching (Hebrews 10:23-25).*
- 3) Be Baptized in the Holy Spirit: *I indeed baptize you with water to repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire (Matthew 3:11).*
- 4) Pray in the Spirit: *But you, beloved, build yourself up in your most holy faith. Pray in the Holy Spirit (Jude 1:20).*
- 5) Read your Bible Daily. Meditate on God's Word: *You are already clean through the word I have spoken to you. Remain in me, as I also remain in you (John 15:3-4). But if we walk in the light as He is the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin (1 John 1:7).*
- 6) Resist the Devil: *Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you (James 4:7-8). ..."See, you have become whole. Sin no more lest something worse happens to you" (John 5:14). For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to pulling down of strongholds, casting down every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ (2 Corinthians 10:4-5).*  
Confess sin Immediately: *If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleans us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).*  
Rebuke the enemy! Command him to leave in Jesus Name!
- 7) Tell people what God has done for you. Help others get free: *As you go, preach, saying 'the kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, and cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give (Matthew 10:7-8).*
